Incident Details:	<p>To, Odisha Human Rights Commission (OHRC) Bhubaneswar, Odisha Subject: Complaint Against Non-Registration of FIR by Bharatpur Police Station, DCP and victim harassment for money etc. Date: [21-09-2024] Respected Sir/Madam, We the practicing lawyers of the Orissa High Court are lodging this complaint regarding the refusal of the Bharatpur Police Station in Bhubaneswar to register an FIR concerning the theft of the Honda Shine bike having registered No. OD33Y9331 of one Dhirendra Bhutia of Tala Sahi of Chandrasekharpur, Bhubaneswar, occurred on August 28, 2024. 01. That, Despite repeated attempts to file the FIR and bring the matter to the attention of the authorities, my complaint has been ignored. The Bharatpur Police Station has become embroiled in a syndicate with bike lifters, thereby obstructing justice for victims of theft like myself and allowing criminals to operate with impunity. 02. That, the IIC Dinakrushna Mishra is not registering FIR u/s 173(1) by taking lame excuses as there is no money for the patrol to pursue the accused, we are running with a shortage of staff for law and order. The IIC was booked in the bribery and extortion case while he was the IIC of the Cantonment Police Station but still held an IIC post in the police department violating the rule of law. I want to highlight the following points of concern: 03. That, the PSs have become the torture and extortion centers as the DCP and M is not inspecting the police station as per the provision of the Odisha PMR. Non-Registration of FIR: My complaint regarding the theft was not acknowledged or registered under Section 173(1) of the BNSS-2023 This not only denies me my legal rights but also reflects a systemic failure in law enforcement. Inaccessibility to DCP: I have attempted to meet with the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Bhubaneswar, Mr. Prateek Singh, to discuss this issue, but I have been consistently denied access. This denial implies an alarming lack of accountability and transparency in law enforcement, akin to suggesting that the DCP operates above the law, Larger Than like, GOVERNOR OR PRESIDENT OF INDIA. The DCP caused the extra-judicial murder of Sk Haedar of the Kendrapara under a deep-rooted criminal conspiracy but still held the DCP post in the police department violating the rule of law. Pattern of Inaction: Reports indicate that more than 20 motorcycles have been stolen from the premises of AMRI Hospital, yet no substantial action has been taken to address this crime spree. Instead, the recommendation for a receipt system for the hospital has been made without any efforts to recover the stolen vehicles or investigate the matter thoroughly. Police Syndicate with Antisocial: My interaction with ACP Tapas Pradhan has revealed a dismissive attitude towards the recovery</p>

of my motorcycle. He claimed that my motorcycle's engine had been used in a boat but failed to take any further action or hold anyone accountable for this alleged crime, indicating a disturbing level of corruption and negligence in the police department. The ACP and others categorically stated to the victim that the bike had been dismantled and the engine was used in a Boat so he should not keep any hope for the recovery of the bike thus proving the syndicate of the police department with the antisocial which caused the society and the city of Bhubaneswar is not safe in the hands of Commissionerate police and its corrupt officers. This ACP also caused the murder of the convicted prisoner Sk Haedar of Kendrapara, Bharat Mandal of Cuttack, and many more in 2021 but still holding an ACP post in the police department violating the rule of law. Given these circumstances, I respectfully request that the Odisha Human Rights Commission investigate these allegations of police inaction and corruption at the Bharatpur Police Station. The failure to register my FIR and the unresponsiveness from higher authorities undermine my basic rights and the rights of others who have suffered similar injustices. I hope that the OHRC will take swift action to ensure that accountability is upheld and that victims of crime in Bhubaneswar can seek justice through the proper channels without fear of collusion or corruption. Thank you for your attention to this pressing matter. I hope you will take prompt action to ensure justice and maintain the law.
