**Sirs,**

**Just to let you know, there are the following classes of legal fraternity.**

1. Law Student
2. Law Scholar
3. Law Graduate or lawyer
4. Practicing Lawyer
5. No practicing Lawyer

**01. The definitions of all the classes are not mentioned in the Advocates Act, 1961, which is important to ascertain the rights and obligations of all these classes of the legal fraternity, and since the government is not paying any salary to this legal fraternity like the teachers and doctors so the income of these classes is also a concern which needs to be redressed.**

**02. That section 32 of the Advocates Act 1961 allows any person to appear before the court, etc., as a pleader, whereas the term "pleader" has been removed from the BNSS-2023 even if the same was there in section 2(q) of the CrPC, 1973.**


**03. That the acts should also be mentioned that only a law graduate can have the designation ADVOCATE before his name whether practicing or not.**

**So, you are requested to frame a rule in the Advocates Act, 1961 towards the same and allow the Law Scholar to act as a Legal Practitioner before different forums such as SHRC/NHRC, Women Commission, SSCPCR/CSCPCR, Consumer Commission, Lokayukta, Lokpal, JJ Board and other quasi-judicial forums at least from the beginning to earn the income.**
